

Newberg High School Trap Team 2024 Varsity Lettering Requirements

The following policies define the criteria for receiving a varsity letter in trapshooting at Newberg High School. They are broken into two parts. The first section defines criteria that MUST be met in order to receive a varsity letter for competing on the NHS Trap Team. The second section provides additional criteria for which at least ONE option must be met or accomplished to earn a varsity letter.

Criteria that Must be met:

- 1. Athlete must be in grades 9 through 12.
- 2. Athlete must not miss any of the five competition weeks. COVID related absences will be handled on a case by case basis.
- 3. Athlete must not miss any of the three Practice Weeks without having that absence approved by the head coach in advance of the missed week.
- 4. Athlete must meet all behavioral and grade requirements as established by Newberg School District Policy

In addition, athlete must meet ONE of the following criteria:

1. Athlete must break a perfect score of 25 in one of the official Practice, Reserve, or Competition Rounds shot during the season.

OR

2. Athlete must shoot scores that qualify as Varsity for 5 of the 8 recorded weeks. To qualify as varsity, the athlete's score for the week must be in the top 40% of the scores that week for NHS shooters .

OR

3. Athlete must shoot scores that qualify as Varsity for 3 of the 5 recorded competition weeks (weeks 4 through 8). To qualify as varsity, the athlete's score for the week must be in the top 40% of the scores that week for NHS shooters.

OR

4. Athlete must shoot all 16 scored regular season rounds and have an average for all 16 rounds of 18 or higher.

OR

5. Athlete must shoot all 16 scored regular season rounds and have one of the top five averages of 9-12th grade NHS shooters for their respective gender.

OR

6. Athlete must place in the top 5 for the NHS Team at the State Competition.
